

- Hop-up may be unstable for 200 to 300 rounds after using silicone oil. This is the normal operation of the gun.
- Never use CRC-556, WD40, or other corrosive lubricants.



 Place a few drops of silicone oil or teflon oil into the pellet entrance. After inserting BB pellets into the magazine, fire the gun for up to 200~300 pellets.

2. To complete the cleaning, use the cleaning rod (with cotton) to remove excess oil.

- Do not jam the cleaning rod into the barrel by force.
- Should the BB's remains inside the barrel, point the gun towards a safe direction and discharge any loosened BB's in semi-automatic mode.
